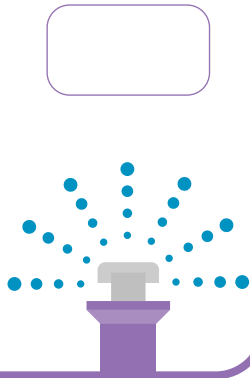


Scavenger Hunt Time!

Welcome to Deschutes Valley Park! This park is built on top of a reclaimed water tank and all of this special water is used to irrigate the Tumwater Valley Golf Course. As you explore the park, look for and answer the scavenger hunt challenges below.

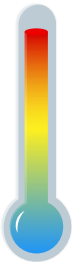
Notice the purple sprinkler heads. These sprinklers use reclaimed water, highly treated wastewater that can be used for almost anything except drinking. How many purple sprinkler heads do you see?



Find the colors of the rainbow! First, look for the colors in nature. If you cannot find them, use the colors from the human-made structures. Which was your favorite color?



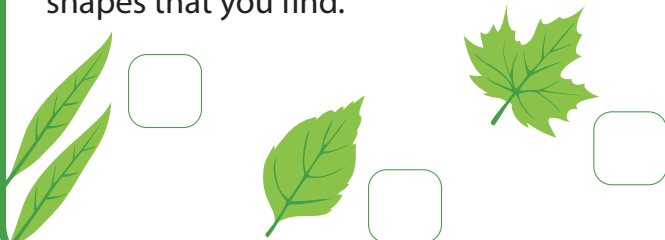
Feel the temperature change. Walk down to where the plants and grass are. What happens to the temperature?



Pause and listen for a moment. What do you hear? Draw something you hear.



Identify leaves of many shapes and sizes. The park has native plants. These plants are adapted to our climate and do not need lots of water. Check the boxes for the leaf shapes that you find.



Animals are hiding in the artwork. The large tile mosaic water drop has ten different water-themed scenes. What animals do you see in the artwork?
